

Other Burial Sites in Boggs Township

Alfred Andrews Burial Site

According to the April 18, 1890 *Democratic Watchman*, "The body of Alfred Andrews was buried the day after the execution from the undertaking establishment of Solomon Confer, in Milesburg, the interment being made on the ridge back of that place. It is believed to have been resurrected by this time, for the use of the Doctors." Andrews was hanged on Wednesday, April 9, 1890, and was buried the 10th.

Ira Green Burial Site

Ira Green, an unfortunate young man, was hanged for the murder of the County Jail Turnkey Jerry Condo on May 9, 1905. From his obituary in the the May 18, 1905 *Bellefonte Republican*, the cemetery association where his parents desired to be buried refused to admit the body. Charles Lucas of Wallace Run offered a piece of ground on his farm for the burial. The lot is 16 feet square and is situated just on top of the divide leading from Runville to Marsh Creek.
