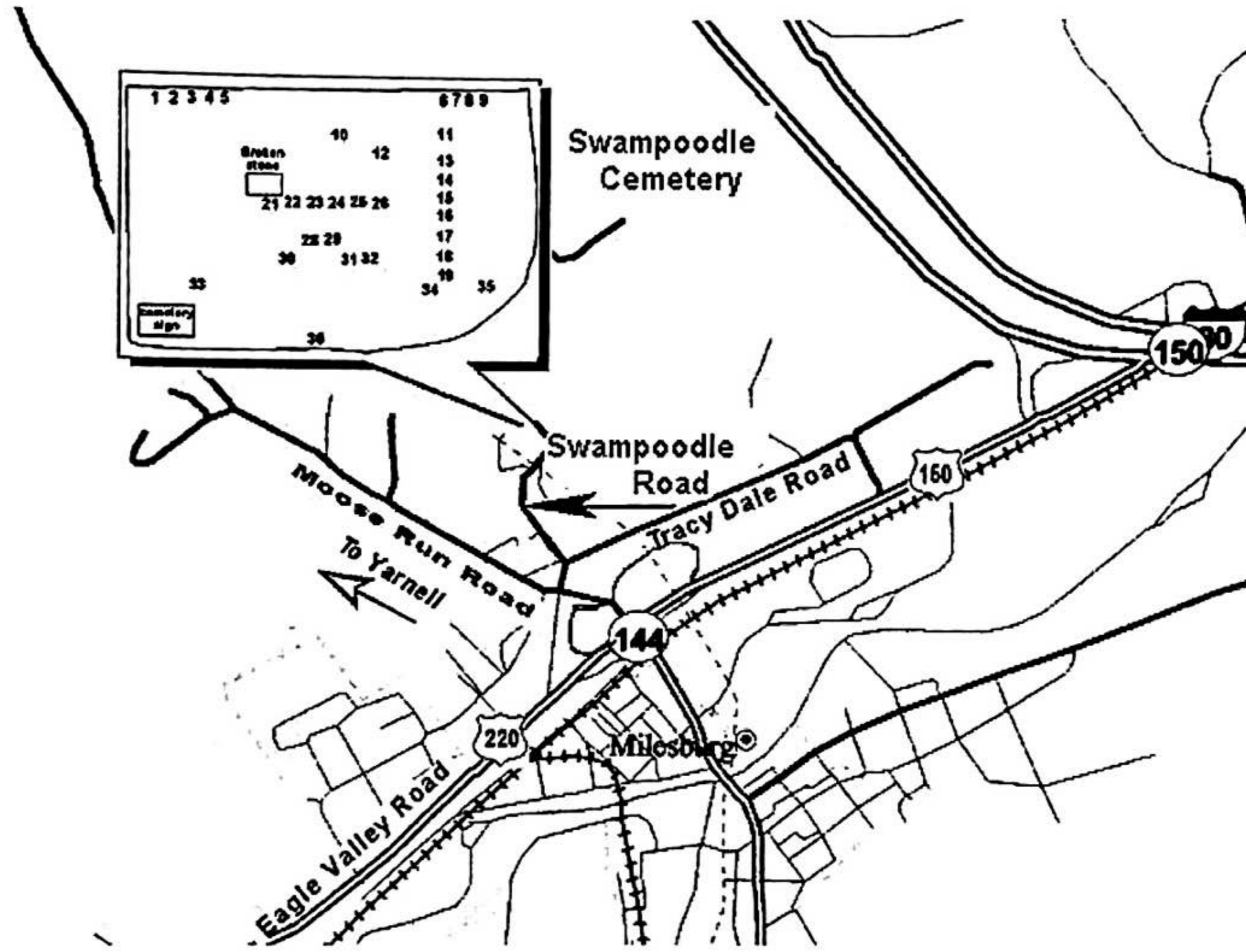


Directions to Swampoodle Cemetery and Sketch Map

From the Dougboy Monument in Milesbugr, take Turnpike/Mill Street (Route 144) west for 0.7 mile. At the intersection of Routes 150 and Alternate 220 cloverleaf, take the 'exit' to Yarnell. The first road on the right is Traceydale Road (there is a double street sign for 'Traceydale Rd' and for 'Swampoodle Rd'). Turn right onto Traceydale Rd. Make an almost immediate left onto Swampoodle Road. The cemetery is 3/10 mile on Swampoodle Road, directly ahead of you at an intersection. N40°57.179' W77°47.607'

History of Swampoodle Cemetery

Swampoodle, a long-abandoned cemetery, was incorporated December 19, 1871. The land was deeded to three Milesburg businessmen – Daniel Boileau, T. M. Hall and Miles Green. It was in use between 1840 and 1905. Members of the Boileau family were interred here as early as 1840. The remains of two victims of the 1875 smallpox epidemic are to be buried in the cemetery.

It is thought the name may have been “Swamp Puddle” as there is often standing water throughout wooded area. At one time it was also known as Belleview Cemetery.
